The Chinese Chamber of Commerce presents a special performance by the Lillian Liao Opera Troupe. This concert will feature a performance of the opera *Green Path and Rainbow: The Story of the Flying Tigers and the Hump*, a tribute to the members of the 1st American Volunteer Group (AVG) of the Chinese Air Force in 1941–1942. Nicknamed the Flying Tigers, the AVG helped defend China against Japanese forces during World War II, with their distinctive shark-face painted fighter planes.

The folk music of Yunnan province's ethnic minorities will also be performed.

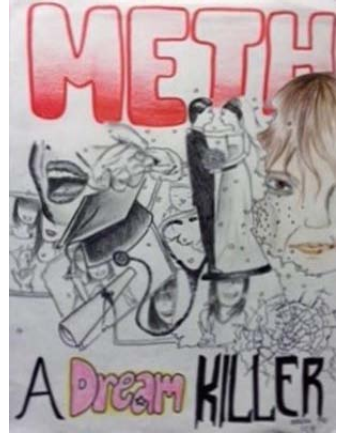
