



175th Anniversary of *Lā Ho'ihō'i Ea:* Sovereignty Restoration Day

July 31, 1843 marked the end of an unauthorized 5-month British occupation of the Kingdom of Hawai'i. After King Kamehameha III petitioned the British government to intervene, Admiral Richard Thomas of the British Royal Navy was dispatched to restore the Kingdom. To commemorate the 175th anniversary of this event, MOCA commissioned a statue of King Kamehameha III to be made and installed at Thomas Square.
